Their mothers are usually single women who are/were abused, deceived, or who became pregnant after having worked as prostitutes. This group is often overlooked by organizations. This will allow them to focus on creating opportunities for them and their child(ren). Education, financial support, and just being a role model is very important for these mothers and their children. Because the KEC organization employs African people, we're not considered to be meddling foreigners, we're one of them!

Democracy, social security, and how the European countries deal with those who aren't able to provide for themselves.
